


ASSOCIATION FOUNDER'S MEMORY LIVES ONJOE CAPONE: AN EDGEWATER ADVOCATE

A proud Edgewater resident for more than 50 years, Joe Capone advocated on behalf of his fellow homeowners. In fact, it is what led to the creation of the Edgewater
Neighborhood Association in 1979. Joe wanted curbs. He found a grant opportunity, but it required that the funds go to a formal organization. So, he and his wife Beverly founded the Association and gathered signatures for its creation.



Joe's daughter, Paula Capone, shared a sentiment on behalf of her father about his love of Edgewater.

"He always said, 'Don't buy the house; buy the neighborhood. Invest your time in your neighborhood, and you will see your quality of life grow.' Dad loved his neighborhood and lived there for 51 years. My parents moved from the East side to the West and were very proud to raise five kids in this neighborhood," said Paula.

Paula shared that, at one point, 57 kids in a one-block radius played together, went to school together, worked together at their part-time jobs, and are still friends to this day. Two of Bev and Joe's five children moved back to the neighborhood to raise their children in Edgewater.

"Joe was a dedicated community leader, serving as past President and board member of Stepping Stones, the Rockford Public Library Board President, and an active member of the YMCA Retired Men's Club. Joe's legacy of service and dedication to ensuring every voice was heard will remain a guiding light for our neighborhood. He will be dearly missed," said Gina Meeks, 12th Ward Alderwoman.

Joe passed away on September 29, 2024. The Edgewater Board expresses its sincere condolences to the Capone family. We are grateful for Joe's passion and determination. Edgewater's beauty and pride of homeownership is not possible without residents like Joe.

12th WARD UPDATE

FROM ALDERWOMAN GINA MEEKS

Hello Edgewater Neighborhood:

I'm thrilled to share some great news! As of October, I am officially a cancer survivor and honored to be named the new Ambassador for the American Cancer Society, highlighting the Voices of Black Women campaign. In even more positive news, our recent budget surplus has passed through City Council, allowing for a \$23 million dollar investment in our community. West Riverside Boulevard will receive a much-needed \$3 million dollar investment in its Capital Improvement Plan, moving its completion date up from 2029 to 2025. Plus, we have secured an additional \$250,000 per ward for the 2025 Ward Plans. This will help address critical infrastructure needs and build on the progress we've made in Edgewater, and throughout the 12th ward.

It's been a blessing to see so many projects completed in our neighborhood, and I look forward to continuing this forward momentum together.




VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!

WHY MEMBERSHIP IS IMPORTANT



The Edgewater Neighborhood Association was established in 1979 to create a greater sense of community and provide resources that help keep Edgewater a beautiful, safe, and inviting place to live. Currently, 192 households have paid the \$30 membership fee for 2024. **GOAL - 50% of the 870 Households as Members**

Your annual membership fee supports:

- Seasonal Neighborhood Activities including the Easter Egg Hunt, Annual Garage Sale, 4th of July Festivities in Oxford Park, Luminaria and the holiday party.
- Snow Plow Fund: The City does not plow Edgewater's alleys, so we pool our
 resources to contract a plow service to keep the alleys clear. These fees are up an
 average of 7%. We spend \$410-\$585 per snowfall depending on inches of snow.
- Plantings at the signs and pots on the bridge.
- Postage and printing for neighborhood mailings as well as signs advertising neighborhood activities.


